All wrestlers must be pre-registered on or by Thursday evening at 10:00 pm prior to the tournament. Club directors or individual members will login into their personal account to register. **All wrestlers must be a MYWA member in order to compete in any MYWA sanctioned event.**

**AWARDS** Custom 3" medals 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> for open and novice. Open Champions receive a custom T-shirt. 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Open Team Trophies.

**ENTRY FEE** \$15, **No Novice Division for age group 07-05.**

**AGE GROUPS** Age Groups are determined by year of birth. (A wrestlers birthday as of December 31, 2011) Proof of age will be required if wrestler is challenged within the first two rounds of competition. A birth certificate is the only form of validation that will be accepted.

- Must be in grade 8<sup>th</sup> or under. Anyone born in 96 must send proof they're in 8<sup>th</sup> when registering for MYWA
- All Michigan residents **MUST** be a MYWA member to compete in post season events.
- Age Groups 07-05, 04-03: three, 1 minute periods
- Age Groups 02-01, 00-99, 98-97 (96 8<sup>th</sup> grade only): three, 1 1/2 minute periods
- Singlets or t-shirt and shorts are required.
- One step on scale at weigh-ins
- Mouth guards **Mandatory** for wrestlers with braces
- Hair caps attached to headgear **Mandatory** for wrestlers not groomed to HS standards. (Hair length must be above eyebrow, earlobes, and collar.)
- If less than three wrestlers are in a weight class, the tournament has the right to move them up one weight class (in the same age group) except for heavyweight.
