## **Dexter Wrestling Parent Pledge Form**

## Please read, initial each item, sign and return to the coach

I pledge to get my child to school, practice and meets, and pick them up on time.  I understand that it can be embarrassing and even dangerous for my child to be late or without a ride home, and that I may be putting him at risk by not providing adequate transportation. This shows respect for my child, his coach, and it demonstrates to my child that he is my top priority.

I pledge to use positive encouragement to build my child's self-confidence. Student-athletes do their best when their self-confidence is high. I understand that children are born with different abilities and that the true measure is not how my child compares to others, but how he is doing in the comparison to his best self. I understand that less than 1% of youth sports participants receive college scholarships. I also understand that the game is for the players and I will keep sports in the proper perspective.

In either case, I will only contribute in a positive way to my child's team culture.
